What is Pretend Play?

Pretend play is also known as imaginative play, which most children develop naturally by around 11 to 18 months of age. This is where a child pretends that there is more happening than what's physically in front of them, such as playing house. As they learn to create more complex stories, children also work on their social and language skills. They learn to communicate their ideas with each other and practice skills such as negotiation, compromise, conflict resolution, problem-solving and perspective taking.
